President for expeditious, inexpensive justice to people



President Dr. Arif Alvi on Monday said it was the constitutional obligation of the state to provide expeditious and inexpensive justice to its people. Talking to Wafaqi Mohtasib, Syed Tahir Shahbaz, who called on him at Aiwan-i-Sadr, the president said Government was taking all possible measures in this regard.
